Seat for Forklift - A seat is a strong, strong surface to be seated, normally raised above floor level. Typically used by a single individual, nearly all seats are supported by four legs, even if a few may be in a triangular shape using just three legs. A stool is a seat which does not have a back or any arm rests. A kind of seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, while a seat with arms only is considered an arm seat. When a seat has attached wheels, it can be referred to as a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is known as a swing. A permanently attached seat in a theatre or a train is referred to as a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type used inside cars and an infant car seat will be a seat particularly intended for young kids.

The design of the seat can vary somewhat significantly so as to accommodate many requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an instance, designs can be decorated with drilled openings, could include gaps or low backs for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back can be designed as an included headrest by way of extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats may be constructed with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool that is intended to be used as a movable footrest. Every so often the ottoman could be attached to a glider chair with swing arms, permitting the ottoman to rock back and forth along with the glider like a rocking chair with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary cloth covers utilized for a seat that could offer protection against wear and add attractiveness. A large range of seat covers from neoprene to leather are presently available. More formal materials could be rented for events like for instance weddings to be able to improve the decoration. Several seat covers have decorative seat ties or ribbons attached to be tied at the back of the seat in a ribbon or decorative knot. Some folks make use of custom clear plastic furniture covers in order to protect their expensive sofas and seats.

Seat pads offer cushioning for hard seats, even if several are usually decorative. Some can also be used so as to increase a driver's height in motor vehicles. Additionally, orthopaedic backrests offer lower spine and lumbar support. Various manufacturers have their seat pad designs patented and are recognized by some medical associations. Several of the newer car seats on the market are equipped with built-in and adjustable lumbar supports to provide extra ease to riders as well as drivers of the vehicle.
