

Cascade Clamps

Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first hiring four people. Product sales for their first year of operation totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different components. Through 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Now, Cascade is amongst the top international producers in the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of better business opportunities. Over the last 60 years, the material handling trade has developed into a highly advanced area and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this development. Cascade currently continues to grow as the best provider of lift truck attachments and numerous associated products. The company feels confident in their potential so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, fabricating and promoting hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was done in 1956 on a brand new facility in order to house all plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current headquarters. After 15 years of business, total workers reached 180 employees and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, El Monte the next manufacturing facility was built. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry when the business recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production plants within the U.S. with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, El Monte, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade merchandise are manufactured internationally thanks to lots of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 after acquiring 5 firms, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide leader in blades.
